Coverage:

- 1. Eligible, meets all criteria.
- 2. Eligible, meets all criteria.
- 3. Not eligible, it is a postgraduate course and not an undergraduate course or integrated masters.
- 4. Not eligible, HNC and when converted to full-time is only 1 year.
- 5. Not eligible, although the majority of the course is taught in the UK and is over 1 year when converted to full-time the course starts in the 2020/21 academic year.
- 6. The registering provider would be responsible for these courses.
- 7. A separate return would need to be made for each award level.

Provider & Location entities:

- 1. Your UKPRN can be found on the UKRLP website.
- 2. When a provider franchises courses in or out.
- 3. Student support.
- 4. MC (or any valid two-letter code).
- 5. 6 decimal places.

Course entity:

- 1. You would end up with the qualification aim in the title twice. E.g.: BSc BSc Physics.
- 2. KISMODE should equal '3'.
- 3. DISTANCE should be submitted as optionally available (2).
- 4. NUMSTAGE only applies to full-time.
- 5. ACCDEPEND should equal '1' and ACCDEPENDURL should hold a link to information about the module choices required for an accredited award.
- 6. 2, a CourseLocation entity should be created for each location the course is taught at.
- 7. SANDWICH and YEARABROAD.

Data linking:

- 1. When KISMODE equals '3'.
- 2. 2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17 (e.g.: ILRYEAR=2014/2015/2016).
- 3. Provider's choice, based on similarity of the course in the year before.
- 4. Two years of subject level 3 data.
- 5. Subject level 2, this is the first level with data above the publication threshold for DLHE.
- 6. The data could have been aggregated or the links to previous year's data may have been made incorrectly.
- 7. KISMODE and LDCS (or you could choose to return a HECOS code instead of LDCS).
