## Open letter consultation: proposed new name for NCH at Northeastern Limited

NCH at Northeastern Limited has applied to the OfS to change its name to 'Northeastern University – London'. This open letter invites views on whether the proposed new name is, or has the potential to be, confusing or misleading.

The Higher Education and Research Act 2017 amended relevant legislation to give the Office for Students (OfS) the power to approve the use of the word 'university' in a registered higher education provider's name.<sup>1</sup>

The OfS has published guidance for registered higher education providers that wish to use either 'university' or 'university college' as part of their name ('university title' or 'university college title').<sup>2</sup> In that guidance, the OfS states that it will consult on a provider's proposed new name and assess the extent to which the proposed name is confusing or misleading.<sup>3</sup>

NCH at Northeastern Limited (<u>www.nchlondon.ac.uk/</u>), also known as New College of the Humanities, is an OfS-registered higher education provider.<sup>4</sup> It has applied to the OfS for university title and proposes to change its name to 'Northeastern University – London'.

The purpose of this open letter is to consult, in line with Regulatory advice 13, on whether NCH at Northeastern Limited's proposed name 'Northeastern University – London' is, or may be, confusing or misleading. We are inviting views on the following questions:

We are particularly (but not only) interested in hearing from:

- Existing or potential future students of NCH at Northeastern Limited.
- Other providers of education with a similar geographic descriptor or based in the same geographic area.
- Professional organisations and local employer groups that work with NCH at Northeastern Limited.
- Local, regional or other bodies with similar names to the proposed name 'Northeastern University – London'.
- Local emergency services to NCH at Northeastern Limited.
- Higher education membership groups.
