

Richmond, the American International University in London, Inc. – Specific ongoing conditions of registration

During the initial registration and assessment process the Office for Students (OfS) has imposed one specific ongoing condition of registration.

1. Specific ongoing condition of registration imposed in relation to Condition E2 (management and governance arrangements)

As set out in paragraph 83 of the regulatory framework, it may be possible for a provider to meet the requirement of being an English higher education provider without being a legal entity that is incorporated in England or the United Kingdom, for example where a provider incorporated overseas carries on the majority of its higher education activities in England.

As set out in paragraph 84 of the regulatory framework, the OfS may impose a specific condition of registration to ensure that a provider not incorporated in England or the United Kingdom will submit to English law and the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales in proceedings relating to its English higher education provision (including where this is provided by a subcontractor).

As a provider not incorporated in England or the United Kingdom but carrying on the majority of its higher education activities in England, Richmond, the American International University in London, Inc. is eligible to be registered with the Office for Students and the OfS is imposing a specific condition of registration as per paragraph 84 of the Regulatory Framework.

The text set out below constitutes the specific ongoing condition imposed on Richmond, the American International University in London, Inc. pursuant to section 6(1) of the Higher Education and Research Act 2017 and is to be referred to as “Specific Ongoing Condition E2A (Richmond, the American International University in London, Inc.)”.

Specific Ongoing Condition E2A (Richmond, the American International University in London, Inc.)

Requirement to comply with paragraph 84 of the Regulatory Framework

Specific Ongoing Condition E2A (Richmond, the American International University in London, Inc.)

Requirement to submit to English law and the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales

E2A.1 The provider must comply with the following requirement:

(a) it must submit to English law and the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales in proceedings relating to its English higher education provision (including where this is provided by a subcontractor).
