


The Princeton University Preparatory

PUPP History and Local Context

- Founded in 2001 following an internal University review of the flow of applicants from first-generation and lowincome backgrounds to Princeton
- Modeled, in part, after long-standing college preparation programs that address educational inequities like Upward Bound which began in 1965 and is funded through the Federal Government's TRIO programs
- Designed to provide students (PUPP Scholars) with academic opportunities on campus at Princeton as well personal development, cultural engagement, college tours, family support, and individualized guidance through the college admissions and financial aid process – and to alter the college-going patterns of targeted students (and peers)




New Jersey map




Mercer County Map

City/Town	School	Characteristics
Trenton	Trenton Central High School	Among the poorest cities in NJ, over 60% of students qualify for free or reduced price lunch; divers population with significant influx of Hispanic immigrants; about 16 km from University
Ewing	Ewing High School	Borders Trenton, almost 50% eligible for free or reduced lunch (F/R)
Hamilton	Nottingham High School	Borders Trenton, diverse student population, 50% eligible for F/R lunch
Lawrence	Lawrence High School	Borders Trenton, not as diverse student population, 30% eligible for F/R lunch
Princeton	Princeton High School	Among the top performing high schools in the state/nation; 8% eligible for free/reduced lunch; mostly white; about 1 km from University



Local and "highly engaged"

- Leadership is sensitive to the nuances and complexities of each school and community context
- Three team members are PUPP Alumni
- Nurturing partnerships with area schools for over two decades
 - Program in Teacher Preparation
 - Memoranda of Understanding with District Leadership
 - PUPP Summer Instructors also teach at partner schools
 - Provide additional supports through Greater Trenton College
 Access Network
 - Coordinate with University units that also engage with schools
 - Strive to be good colleagues





Socioeconomic Status










PUPP serves 69 scholars in the classes of 2022-24 and over 425 alumni from the classes of 2004-2021

75% degree attainment vs. 11% for low-income peers


Majority in the top 15% of high school class






